Constituency & Task Force Reports

Roger Barlow, Elevation Taskforce Chair

- 1) Final deliverables of the South Jersey LiDAR collection are expected to be available in the spring.
- 2) Elevation Taskforce will be meeting January 8, 2020 10 a.m. at NJOIT, 300 Riverview Plaza, ITC Room, Trenton, NJ

Doug Schleifer, Office of GIS

- 1) Aerial photography will be collected late winter, early spring. NJDEP is the lead on the contract. It is expected that the imagery will be available by the end of 2020 or early 2021. The collection will have 1 ft. resolution, 4-band, +/- 4 ft.
- 2) Current parcels under review include: Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Bergen, and Warren. There is no timetable for completion.
- 3) Next Generation 911
 - Finalizing NENA data model and template for NJ road centerlines, address points and landmarks
 - Address points will be moved to within building footprints this month
 - Working on validation processes and tools
 - County-by-County correction of known issues will begin January 2020
 - Overall NG911 GIS standards development will begin 2020
- 4) State Boundary Reconciliation Project NJ/NY/PA
 - Determination of state jurisdiction down to one island (Punkey's Island) in the Delaware River above the Water Gap
 - NY accepted our coincident state boundary delineation in full
- 5) School location updates are under final QA/QC review.

Nathan MacLean, Trails Task Force

- 1) The taskforce has been making progress on the trails database and will be making the draft schema available for review. It looks like there may be a potential funding source to move forward with the project. The taskforce will be seeking trails and trailhead data.
- 2) The Trails Taskforce will be meeting on January 22 in Trenton. Exact location is TBD.
