- Elevation Task Force – topobathymetric for Barnegat Bay due to be released to the public sometime really soon (within the next two to three weeks)
- Will check in with NOAA to find out about the LiDAR data they collected along the coast.
  - What's available, when it will be available, and where will it be available from?
- Broad agency announcement has been extended once again, this time due November 7<sup>th</sup> (specific to new LiDAR data collection)
- Warren/Sussex reprocessed data up and available – in the works to make it available in the public domain

- MODIV data update (2014) will be available soon (2 weeks) through the data warehouse site.

Craig Coutros (NJDEP) – Land Use Data update: Status 60% of coverage area, working from South to North is complete. Sandy Hook south is complete. NHD codes have been added in to the water bodies within the land use data.
