Constituency & Task Force Reports

State GIO, Andy Rowan

- 1) NJDEP datasets that are registered in the Office of GIS's ArcGIS Online portal are being deprecated. The services are no longer discoverable. Web applications using these services will need to be updated to point to the correct map service URLs.
- 2) New parcels dataset will be available in approximately four weeks.
- 3) The Address Point dataset is being migrated to the NENA model. Estimated to be completed this summer.
- 4) State agencies are meeting to secure funding for the 2020 aerial imagery collection at 12-inch resolution statewide. Counties/Regional agencies can get 6-inch resolution if they pay the difference.
- 5) New award for GIS Services Contract is nearly done. Current contract is set to expire June 18, 2019. If it is not awarded by June 18, the contract will be extended.
- 6) Leslie O'Hara has joined the Office of GIS.

Maya Thomas, Office of GIS

- 1) Color basemap and light gray basemap map services have been updated and now include present day communities, historic settlements, and passenger rail lines and stations.
- 2) New order form for Imagery and LiDAR. The form must be completed, printed, signed, and included with the external hard drive. Forms are available on the NJGIN website.

Brian Embley, Office of GIS

- 1) Staff from the Office of Information Technology is present to produce a podcast about GIS.
- 2) Office of GIS is the administrative arm of the Geospatial Forum. The Geospatial Forum will utilize digital sign in in the future. The current Geospatial Forum membership database includes 5,000 member accounts. This database is being cleaned up. If you are registered, you will receive an e-mail in six weeks asking you to click a link to validate your account.
- 3) New NJGIN website will be launched by the end of this month. The Office of GIS is tracking Open Data statistics. If you are interested in getting statistics for your data, contact the Office of GIS.
- 4) New Geospatial Forum website will also be launched this month.

- 2) The Bureau of GIS is continuing its transition to Esri's Open Data platform. Over 100 layers are currently registered.

- 3) Andy indicated that NJDEP layers registered in ArcGIS online that are owned by the Office of GIS are being deprecated. Contact the Bureau of GIS Help Desk if assistance is needed with switching your URLs for map services consumed in your web mapping applications at GISNET@dep.nj.gov.
- 4) The Bureau of GIS is hiring a GIS Specialist 3. The position closes on June 7.
