Constituency & Taskforce Reports

- Federal
 - Federal Lidar requirements for FY17 acquisition season must be entered into NOAA Seasketch app no later than June 17, 2016 for consideration. In the case of a 3-4 way overlap or more, funds may be allocated to capture areas of multi-agency need.
 - USGS National Geospatial Program – announcement for FY17 Broad Agency Announcement for lidar project proposals will be released July 25th and due Oct 3rd. Notifications will be made by mid-November. Funding will be allocated with respect to Congressional budget passage or a CR.
- State
 - Andy has taken the position of Deputy Chief Technology Officer and Doug Schleifer will become manager of the Office of GIS.
 - Version 1.0 statewide address points have been released on NJGIN. Primary source is property tax records and parcel data. If Counties have data to share, please contact Chris Klaube. Feedback and corrections are welcome.
 - The Division of Elections is in the design phase to incorporate GIS into the statewide voter system, which means an update to statewide data voting districts.
 - An RFP will be released on July 1 for next generation 911 implementation. The State will provide network routing of 911 calls into the network, call routing, and identification of call location to the correct call center.
 - The State Division of Taxation is preparing to release a request for quotes for staff training & for tools to assist in automating tax map review. Regulations have been drafted but are on hold. The Division has the discretion to receive tax maps in alternate formats, which would enable them to receive digital submissions. Even if the regulations were changed, submitting digital tax maps would be voluntary and it is expected that there will be a partial adoption of the digital submission.
- County
 - The first County constituency group meeting was held in May, with a good turnout. The next meeting will be in the Fall.
- Boundary Taskforce
 - The first meeting of the taskforce is to be held on June 22nd at 1pm at Mercer County DOT complex. A signup is being circulated via the listserv. Mission statement, goals and objectives will be discussed at the meeting.
