Re: Termination of Tele Atlas (Tom Tom) site license

Please read this letter, then sign the attached License Termination Statement and return it by July 16, 2012, signifying that you understand and agree to the terms of the license termination.

For the last several years, The New Jersey Office of Information Technology (NJOIT) and the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety have sponsored an enterprise site license for Tele Atlas (now Tom Tom) GIS data that includes road centerlines and other common base data. As has been previously announced, this license is being discontinued effective June 30, 2012. All users that have received data under this license must remove it from all operational systems and delete all copies of the data. Rights to use the data under the enterprise license will end June 30, 2012. If your agency wishes to continue using the data, you must contact Tom Tom to enter into and pay for a new licensing agreement for your organization.

The reason for the discontinuation of the license is that NJOIT and the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) have conducted a project to make enhancements to the existing NJDOT roadway network GIS data to make it suitable for address geocoding and other related functions, thus removing most of the need for the Tom Tom data by New Jersey state and local government agencies. The primary difference is that the new State of New Jersey data set will not support automated routing. Organizations requiring that functionality will need to acquire their own license for a commercial product.

The new road centerlines data, which complements the existing NJDOT Roadway Network data, are available to all users without cost or restriction. License Termination Statement for Tele Atlas (now Tom Tom) data

I hereby state that my agency is no longer using, for any purpose, the TomTom MultiNet Enterprise data, TomTom Post Zip Code Boundaries, TomTom Administrative Areas, and TomTom Street Map Premium map data for the state of New Jersey and /or any surrounding counties that was obtained under the New Jersey statewide license from 2005 through 2012. Furthermore, I hereby state that all copies of the data which I am terminating have been removed from any and all computers and that I have destroyed any and all copies that have been made. No components of the TomTom MultiNet Enterprise data, TomTom Post Zip Code Boundaries, TomTom Administrative Areas, and TomTom Street Map Premium data have been used or incorporated into any other products that I am using.

I understand that if my agency intends to continue using any of the above-mentioned Tom Tom products after June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012, it is my agency's responsibility to arrange a license with Tom Tom or one of its resellers, and pay the appropriate licensing fee for the data involved.
